Gregory School's Week of Respect

October 7th- October 11th

The Anti-Bullying Bill of Rights Act (P.K.2010, c.122) requires that the week beginning with the first Monday in October of each year be designated as the Week of Respect in New Jersey. School districts observe this week by providing age-appropriate instruction focusing on preventing/remediating harassment, intimidation, and/or bullying.



Monday- October 7th- Stomp Out Bullying & Wear Blue

- October 7th is world day of bullying prevention, wear **BLUE** to support!

Tuesday- October 8th – RESPECT: What does it mean to me?

- Teachers will write the word RESPECT at the top of the board or on chart paper and ask students to discuss the meaning of the word. Teachers will then introduce the “thanks for showing RESPECT worksheet” and invite students to fill out a form whenever they witness an example of a classmate showing respect to another student, teacher, or a visitor in the classroom.

Wednesday- October 9th- Helping Hands Activity

- Teachers will have students write ways they can help each other. Hands will displayed throughout the APR.

Thursday- October 10th- Chalk it up to Respect- Kindness in chalk on the walkways.

- Students will participate in writing uplifting messages on the walkways to spread kindness outside of our school.
