IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENTS

Dear Parent/Guardian:

At the time of registration, please submit proof of the following information.

- <u>Physical Examination Record:</u> A physical <u>must</u> be provided to central registration during the registration process. Students entering PK3 must have a current physical within 6 months of registration. Students entering grades PK4 Grade 12 must have a current physical within 12 months of registration. If physical is not in the current school year a new physical must be provided within 30 days of registration.
- <u>Immunization Record</u> consisting of dates of Primary Series and booster doses. **N.J.A.C. Chapter 14** requires that immunizations must be complete and up-to-date, otherwise, the student may be excluded from school.

1. DTP: Diphtheria and Tetanus Toxoids and Pertussis Vaccine (DTP)

- a. FOUR (4) doses for children entering PK 3 or PK 4.
- b. FIVE (5) doses for children entering Kindergarten through Grade 12.
- c. Tdap: Required on all sixth grade students born on or after January 1, 1997.

2. Poliovirus Vaccine

- a. THREE (3) doses for those children entering PK 3 or PK 4.
- b. **FOUR (4)** doses for children entering Kindergarten through Grade 12.

3. Measles, Mumps and Rubella Vaccine (MMR)

- a. **ONE (1)** dose of MMR after 1st birthday.
- b. TWO (2) doses of MMR for children entering Kindergarten through Grade 12.

4. Hepatitis B Vaccine - PK3 through Grade 12

a. Appropriate three (3) doses Hepatitis Vaccine, or laboratory evidence of immunity.

5. Varicella Virus Vaccine (Chicken Pox)

- a. ONE (1) dose after the first birthday is required OR...
- b. Statement of past history of chicken pox or laboratory evidence of immunity is required for all students born after January 1, 1998.

6. Meningococcal Vaccine

- a. ONE (1) dose required on or after 11th birthday.
- 7. Haemophilus Influenza B (HIB) ONE (1) dose required after first (1st) birthday.
- 8. **Pneumococcal** Minimum **ONE** (1) dose after first (1st) birthday.
- 9. Flu Vaccine (Influenza) ONE (1) dose annually during current school year (Pre-school only).
- 10. <u>Mantoux Tuberculin Test</u>: Required ONLY on those students entering the Long Branch School System coming directly from another country as directed by the state department of health.

Students entering this district are REQUIRED to provide appropriate immunization records prior to entry.
