A-1. STATEMENT OF THE MANNER OF NOTIFICATION OF THE MEETING

Peter E. Genovese III, RSBO, QPA, School Business Administrator/Board Secretary stated adequate notice of the meeting of the Long Branch Board of Education has been provided by a Schedule of Public Meetings published in the <u>Asbury Park Press.</u> Mr. Genovese further stated a Schedule of Public Meetings has been posted in the Board of Education Office and the Office of the City Clerk, Long Branch, New Jersey.

B. FLAG SALUTE AND PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

Mr. Covin, Board President, saluted the flag and led the Pledge of Allegiance.

C-1. STATEMENT TO THE PUBLIC

Mr. Covin made the following announcement: Often times it may appear to members of our audience that the Board of Education takes action with very little comment and in many cases by unanimous vote. Before a matter is placed on the agenda at a public meeting, the administration has thoroughly reviewed the matter with the Superintendent of Schools. If the Superintendent of Schools is satisfied that the matter is ready to be presented to the Board of Education, it is then referred to the appropriate Board committee. The members of the Board committee work with the administration and Superintendent to assure that the members fully understand the matter. When the committee is satisfied with the matter, it is presented to the Board of Education for discussion before any final action is taken. Only then is it placed on the agenda for action at a public meeting. All agenda attachments are available for public review. In rare instances, matters are presented to the Board of Education for discussion at the same meeting that final action may be taken.

Time may be allocated for public comment at this meeting. Each speaker may be allotted up to three (3) minutes and one (1) opportunity to address the Board when recognized by the presiding officer. Individuals wishing to address the Board shall be recognized by the presiding officer and shall give their names, addresses and the group, if any, that they represent. Although the Board encourages public participation, it reserves the right, through its presiding officer, to terminate remarks to and/or by any individual not in keeping with the conduct of a proper and efficient meeting. With the exception of those individuals whose names are on the agenda this evening, the Board will not respond to questions during the public participation portion of this meeting involving the employment, appointment, termination of employment, negotiations, terms and conditions of employment, evaluation of the performance of, promotion or disciplining of any specific, prospective or current employee.

C-2. OPPORTUNITY TO ADDRESS THE BOARD RELATING TO AGENDA ITEMS

Vinnie Lepore 33 Ocean Terrace Long Branch, NJ 07740

Mr. Lepore expressed his dismay with the Mayor regarding the re-allocation of \$14,000 of Cable Commission funds to Monmouth University for the purpose of promoting "himself". He stated that he would have preferred the funds to be made available to Jessica Sickler for the High School TV studio.

Mr. Grant arrived at 7:08 P.M.

PRESENTATION BY A REPRESENTATIVE OF WISS & CO OF THE JUNE 30, 2019 AUDIT

Mr. Kaplan reviewed with the Board the June 30, 2019 audit. He stated that in the 3 major areas, financial statements, internal controls compliance and single audit, all received an unmodified opinion which is the highest opinion you can receive in those areas. He discussed some of the challenges with Systems 3000 being cloud based as well as the ESIP program which was new for the audit. With regard to the financial conditions and health of the district, he stated that we are in excellent shape, better than last year. The general fund unassigned fund balance was positive. The remaining deficit in the internal service fund was only \$119,000 down from the original \$2 million. The district had a strong cash position at year end which allowed it to borrow only one State Aid payment versus the borrowing of 2 payments in previous years. The Board ended up with approximately \$544,000 in excess surplus.

Mr. Kaplan also explained that there are 3 audit findings this year. The first deals with student activity funds. He explained that the law requires deposits to be made within 48 hours however during his testing of several receipts, it was unclear as to the date the funds were taken in. The second finding is with the National School Lunch Program. He stated that the Board is required to review 3% of all of the error prone applications for which there were 40 this year. On one record of the 40, a child was determined to be fully paid but should have been reduced. This was done through a clerical error but due to the nature of the single audit, this has to be reported as well. The third finding deals with general fund transfers exceeding 10%. Mr. Kaplan explained that certain accounts, when a transfer in or out exceeds 10% of the original budgeted

line item, it needs to be reported to the County Office. If the County does not respond within 2 weeks, the transfers are deemed to be automatically approved. However, the Board did not transmit any budget transfers to the County Office for approval. On a final note, Mr. Kaplan explained that Ransomware is becoming quite a problem in New Jersey and in Monmouth County and cautioned the Board.

Mr. Kaplan left the meeting.

Dr. Salvatore asked Mr. Genovese to explain the Corrective Action Plan (CAP) associated with each finding.

Mr. Genovese - With regard to the 3% verification of error prone lunch applications, next year after the staff completes the process, the Fiscal Analyst will review all records prior to submission. Regarding the Student Account funds not being deposited within the 48 hour time frame, we have had this problem from year to year with different accounts which is not unusual considering the amount of deposits that are made annually. The plan for this year is to ensure that everyone has a receipt book that they will be instructed to date and keep a copy for every deposit they receive prior to it being deposited in the bank. Periodically someone from the Business Office will review the records. With regard to the transfers, several years ago when Monmouth County had an Executive School Business Administrator, the review of the 10% transfers was very lax. Subsequently, Monmouth County does not have a Business Administrator nor does Ocean County, so we have contacted the Atlantic County Executive School Business Administrator and Nancy is working with her to determine exactly what she needs with respect to this process.

Comments from the Finance Committee Chair - Lucille Perez

Mrs. Perez briefed the Board on the items discussed with the members of the Finance Committee.

Dr. Salvatore briefed the Board on the emergency drill that was coordinated with the Long Branch Police Department and held at the High School. He described the scenario and the process and explained that he will be working closely with Jason Roebuck in the areas that need improvement.



The team is comprised of at least 2 to 3 staff members from each of the buildings and they have been charged with creating a school level committee that will work collaboratively with the school community to promote this important theme.

NOTICE TO PLAN PARTICIPANTS OF CERTAIN NON-PARTICIPATING PROVIDERS TO WHOM NO CLAIMS SHALL BE REIMBURSED

In addition to determinations of eligibility, medical necessity, and applicability of covered services, non-participating provider reimbursements under the Plan are predicated upon compliance with the Plan's standards for reasonable and conscientious billing practices. Failure by a non-participating provider to comply with reasonable and conscientious billing practices can expose Plan Participants to sole responsibility for the full costs of medically unnecessary services. To avoid continued exposure of Plan Participants to such out-of-pocket costs, the Plan Sponsor reserves the right to disqualify any non-participating provider that fails to meet the standards for reasonable and conscientious billing practices as defined below, from receiving any reimbursement for claims submitted to the Plan.

A determination may be made that a non-participating provider failed to meet the standards for reasonable and conscientious billing practices if ten percent (10%) or more of its total claims submitted to the Plan in any ninety (90) day period were denied for (a) failure to provide medical records; (b) failure to demonstrate medical necessity; (c) duplication of claims; (d) submission of experimental/investigational services; or (e) submission of services that are not covered under the Plan. The percentage of claims shall be calculated from the combined total number of claims denied for reasons listed in (a) through (e) as stated above, as determined by the Third-Party Administrator, and the total number of claims submitted in the applicable ninety (90) day period by the non-participating provider for the benefit of any Plan Participant.

A non-participating provider that is determined to have failed to meet the reasonable and conscientious billing practices standards shall receive a Notice of Violation by certified and regular mail, detailing the Plan's requirements and standards for reasonable and conscientious billing practices and identifying the manner in which the non-participating provider has violated same. Any non-participating provider that continues to violate the standards for reasonable and conscientious billing practices after the Notice of Violation is received, may be disqualified from reimbursement under the Plan at the Plan's discretion.

Notice of Decision to Disqualify a non-participating provider from future reimbursement under the Plan shall be sent by mail to the provider and to all Plan Participants, at least forty-five (45) days in advance of the designated treatment cut-off date. Claims submitted by the disqualified non-participating provider for dates of service prior to the treatment cut-off date, shall be processed in accordance with the Plan provisions. Any claims for services rendered on or after the designated treatment cut-off date shall be denied.
