MINUTES

FEBRUARY 26, 2013

The Agenda Meeting of the Long Branch Board of Education was held at 540 Broadway, Long Branch, New Jersey. The meeting was called to order by Mrs. Beams, Board President, at 7:00 P.M.

A-1. STATEMENT OF THE MANNER OF NOTIFICATION OF THE MEETING

Peter E. Genovese III, RSBO, QPA, School Business Administrator/Board Secretary stated adequate notice of the meeting of the Long Branch Board of Education has been provided by a Schedule of Public Meetings published in the Atlanticville and the Asbury Park Press. He further stated a Schedule of Public Meetings has been posted in the Board of Education Office and the Office of the City Clerk, Long Branch, New Jersey.

Mr. Genovese made the following announcement: Fire exits are located in the direction indicated. In case of fire, you will be signaled by bell and/or public address system. If so alerted to fire, please move in a calm and orderly fashion to the nearest smoke-free exit.

A-2. OBJECTIONS, IF ANY, TO THE VALIDITY OF THE MEETING

Mr. Genovese stated that the objecting member must give supporting reasons.

B. FLAG SALUTE AND PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

Mrs. Beams, Board President, saluted the flag and led the Pledge of Allegiance.

C-1. STATEMENT TO THE PUBLIC

Mrs. Beams made the following announcement: Often times it may appear to members of our audience that the Board of Education takes action with very little comment and in many cases by unanimous vote. Before a matter is placed on the agenda at a public meeting, the administration has thoroughly reviewed the matter with the Superintendent of Schools. If the Superintendent of Schools is satisfied that the matter is ready to be presented to the Board of Education, it is then referred to the appropriate Board committee. The members of the Board committee work with the administration and Superintendent to assure that the members fully understand the matter. When the committee is satisfied with the matter, it is presented to the Board of Education for discussion before any final action is taken. Only then is it placed on the agenda for action at a public meeting.

C-1. STATEMENT TO THE PUBLIC (continued)

Time may be allocated for public comment at this meeting. Each speaker may be allotted a limited time when recognized by the presiding officer. Individuals wishing to address the Board shall be recognized by the presiding officer and shall give their names, addresses and the group, if any, that they represent. Although the Board encourages public participation, it reserves the right, through its presiding officer, to terminate remarks to and/or by any individual not in keeping with the conduct of a proper and efficient meeting. The Board will not respond to questions during the public participation portion of this meeting involving the employment, appointment, termination of employment, negotiations, terms and conditions of employment, evaluation of the performance of, promotion or disciplining of any specific, prospective or current employee.

C-2. OPPORTUNITY TO ADDRESS THE BOARD RELATING TO AGENDA ITEMS

No one addressed the Board.

C-3. BOARD UPDATE

Mrs. Beams spoke to the Board with respect to 2 questions she received from Board members; Mr. Grant inquired about the scholarship process and Mr. Menkin regarding report cards. Mrs. Beams stated due to the length of the agenda she would like to table those discussions for now.

The Board engaged in a discussion with respect to the Superintendent's evaluation as well as the Board of Education's self evaluation. The concerns dealt with the timing and dates available for both. Currently on March 20, 2013 there is a 6:00 P.M. start time for the Board of Education Agenda meeting which was originally set for the Superintendents evaluation. The regular agenda meeting will begin at the conclusion of the evaluation which would also make the Finance Committee meeting start at 5:30 on March 20, 2013. This year the methodology for completing the evaluations would be on line through New Jersey School Boards versus the paper process done in previous years. There were concerns over the password issues as well as concerns whether members could see the paper version prior to going on line. Additionally Mrs. Beams stated that she needs to open the window for these evaluations to commence and she would do that this evening upon conclusion of the Board meeting.

Mrs. Beams – I will also be looking at Board goals for the upcoming year and to insure that the committees that were impacted by these goals will be able to give reports from time to time in those areas. I will get back to the administration tomorrow with respect to the Board meetings, either adding a new one for the purposes of evaluations or modifying the current times of the existing meetings to accommodate the process.

Mr. Salvatore recommended the possibility of having another Finance Committee meeting before March 21, 2013 for the purpose of further reviewing the budget prior to the public hearing.

Mr. Salvatore discussed with the Board whether the reporting by the committee chair person each month was something that was beneficial to the public.

The Board felt the information is important from time to time but it doesn't appear that the public is focused on the information that is being presented.

C-3. BOARD UPDATE (continued)

Mrs. Perez recommended that we attach the committee reports to the agenda for the public to review. It was further discussed that rather than formal presentations at the beginning of the meeting, when certain items in the agenda trigger a committee area, Mr. Salvatore will ask the chair if there was anything else to add.

C-4. COMMITTEE MEETING REPORTS

1) PERSONNEL – TARA BEAMS - Chair

Mrs. Beams briefed the Board on the following items:

- The current open positions within the technology department are Network Technician which will be filled from within; Computer Technician and Technical Services Manager.
- There are 6 confirmed retirements at this time; 7 other staff members are currently applying for retirement.
- The suspension of an employee with pay, effective February 4, 2013 which is an item in the Agenda.
- Early in-jeopardy letters have been distributed to 15 staff members – 2 teachers will continue with increment withholding from last year.
- We have 18 workers' compensation related injuries to date – 4 slip and falls; 8 related to students; 3 accidents caused by the employee and 3 job related. 4 employees are currently out of work.
- The job description for the Energy Education Manager which was previously discussed.
- The job description for the TV/Broadcasting Advisor.
- State Aid impact on staffing.
- Non-affiliated employees who had a 0% increase in salary based on salary, not alignment to any group.

Mr. Salvatore – You will see on the agenda tonight some title changes in technology because based on the current titles we aren't getting any applicants for the vacancies.

Additionally Mr. Salvatore briefed the Board on the duties of the TV Broadcasting stipend with respect to our television station.

Mr. Zambrano – Regarding the job description of the TV broadcaster, I would like more specific details as to the work that would be accomplished.

Mr. Salvatore – Sometimes it is more important to leave less description to allow room for creativity as in this particular situation.

Mr. Zambrano – Who supervises this stipend?

Mr. Salvatore – Kristen Ferrara.

C-4. **COMMITTEE MEETING REPORTS (continued)**

2) GOVERNANCE – MARY GEORGE – Chair

Mrs. George briefed the Board on the following items:

- A question was asked regarding Policy 0167 – Public Participation in Board Meetings – If someone was speaking and their 5 minutes were up, could the next person waiting to speak give up their 5 minutes. The answer was no, not immediately, but after discussion on a particular item was completed, the person would be allowed to come back up again.
- Clarification of Policy 6164 – Advertising on School Buses – The advertisements would be regulated by the Finance Committee and would require Board approval. The money generated would be spent on the recommendation of the Finance Committee.
- Policy 3230 and Regulation 3230 – Outside Activities and Policy 2468 – Independent Educational Evaluations were discussed and clarified.
- Policy 3281 and Regulation 3281 – Inappropriate Staff Conduct – This policy outlines the following:
 1. Staff members completing their professional responsibilities.
 2. Staff members shall be appropriate at all times.
 3. Staff members shall not make inappropriate comments to pupils or about pupils
 4. Staff members shall not engage in inappropriate language or expressions in the presence of pupils.
 5. Staff members shall not engage in inappropriate conduct towards or with pupils.
 6. Staff members shall not engage or seek to be in the presence of a pupil beyond the staff members professional responsibilities.
 7. Staff members shall not provide transportation to a pupil in their private vehicle or permit a pupil into their private vehicle unless there is an emergency or special circumstances.

Mrs. Perez voiced her concerns with regards to Policy 5111 – Eligibility of Resident/Non-resident Pupils.

Mrs. Perez – In the policy, if the Superintendent feels that certain services are not required for children that fall under the policy that decision would be brought to the Board of Education prior to any decisions being made.

Mr. Salvatore – For critical policies such as this I would try to have quarterly updates to the staff to avoid any misunderstandings.

Mrs. Perez – One of my other concerns is with respect to the policies of inappropriate relationships between staff members and children and whether we as Board members should be adhering to the same standards.

Mr. Salvatore – It is important that all of us abide by and adhere to the policies set forth by the Board of Education. If I were to walk into the High School with my cell phone on, do I get a sanction? The answer is no but in reality I try not to use my cell phone in the school setting. We all should try to follow the policies that we set for others.

Mrs. Critelli – One of the concerns I always have in my own district is driving a child home in my car because we really should not do that. In essence staff should not drive a student home unless it is an emergency. My question is does that pertain to a Board member as well?

Mr. Salvatore – Obviously in an emergency yes, but you always run the risk of the liability associated with driving students home. What may be unclear is how far the liability would extend. Would it be just for the Board member or a possible suit against the whole Board.

Mr. Parnell reiterated a similar situation and stated that if he knows a particular child is walking home and if he sees them, or if it is raining, he would feel inclined to take that child home.

Mrs. Beams stated a similar situation in transporting her daughter and some of her daughter's soccer team members home as well.

Mr. Salvatore – When you are seated here at a meeting you are Board members with certain authority. The question is when do you become just a regular parent or community member.

3) ATHLETICS – LUCILLE PEREZ - Chair

Mrs. Perez briefed the Board on the following topics that were discussed:

- Jason Corley gave a presentation of the winter highlights and some important dates that are coming up.
- The Student Athletic College Fair will be held on April 10, 2013 in the High School gym and is open to all junior and senior athletes throughout the Shore Conference
- The NCAA presentation was done by a private company due to the fact that our Guidance Department is not yet familiar with the process. There were only 20 parents in attendance.
- Green and White update – The booster club is trying to get back on track. The officers are holding a meeting this evening and hope to have a meeting with the full membership in March.
- Spring season begins March 1, 2013

Mrs. Beams – How do announcements get sent home?

Mr. Salvatore – A flyer may go home and sometimes auto calls are made as well, which is how we disseminated the information with respect to PARCC (Partnership for Assessment of Readiness for College and Careers) when it became available.

Mr. Dangler – I've noticed some banners are missing from the old High School.

Mr. Salvatore – I will look into it. If we can't find them we will have some made up again.

A discussion was held with regards to the Athletic Hall of Fame and the Academic Hall of Fame and whether we would be continuing this tradition. There were various discussions by the Board members as to whether they should be a combined event or individual events. At the

conclusion of the discussion, the consensus of the Board was to separate the events into an Athletic Hall of Fame and Academic Hall of Fame to be held on a rotating schedule every 5 years commencing with the Athletic Hall of Fame. The process will most likely begin in the spring of 2014 with the actual event hosted in 2015.

Mr. Dangler – At the last Agenda meeting there was a member here from the press and the Board was discussing paying \$5,000 for a stipend that no one really knew what was expected from the work that was being done. My concern is that the press and the public may take away misconceptions.

Mr. Salvatore – Since it is a public meeting there isn't much we can do about that however if I do recognize that someone is here from the press, I will try to make it a point to mention that.

G. GENERAL ITEMS

1. APPROVAL TO SUBMIT TENTATIVE FY2014 BUDGET TO THE COUNTY OFFICE

I recommend the Board approve the submission of the tentative FY2014 budget to the county office for review and approval prior to March 7, 2013. Upon approval from the County Superintendent, the Board authorizes the Superintendent and School Business Administrator to advertise said budget prior to the public hearing scheduled for March 21, 2013.

Mr. Salvatore gave a lengthy discussion regarding this years budget, highlighting some of the challenges the administration is facing in putting this budget together.

Mr. Salvatore – The most prevalent increase in the budget is health benefits which grew at a rate of 16%, an increase of \$2.3 million for next year. That coupled with the solar payment and the City's loss of ratables at a little over \$70 million has caused significant challenges that we are facing this year. The cap on the tax levy is set for 2% which is approximately \$600,000. We currently do not have the State Aid figures since they will not be released for 2 days. We are facing fiscal problems of sequestration where we stand to lose anywhere from 5% to 8% of our federal budget that supports our IDEA and Title I programs. To date we have received 11 retirements that we are not replacing and we are hoping for a few more. We have also reduced our summer program to 4 days a week. Those 2 items have helped to reduce the increase by \$1.2 million. Our choices to achieve a balanced budget are: either receive 17 more retirements from now until March 21, 2013 which is the date of the public hearing; RIF approximately 26 newly hired non-tenured staff members or take advantage of a process called "bank cap" which will give us the ability to increase taxes and still not require us to go for a vote. Bank cap is something that is authorized in statute that allows districts with an excess increase in health benefits and enrollment, areas that are uncontrollable by a district, to increase taxes to help offset those costs. If districts do not take advantage of that in any one area, allowances for spending growth can be "banked". This is not money but really an authorization to generate more money from the local tax payers. With the loss in ratables, if we kept the same tax levy for next year as we have this year, the tax rate would increase a little over 2 cents. At the original authorized 2% cap, the tax rate would grow to 2.9 cents. The budget that is currently before you that we are looking to transmit to the county is approximately 4.9 cents. This is worst case scenario and without the ability of knowing what State Aid is or the results of the federal governments decision on sequestering. What that 4.9 cents means is that the average tax payer with a home assessed at \$370,000 would pay an increase of approximately \$180 per year. \$70 of that increase would be due to the loss in ratables. We are not recommending this budget be the final adopted budget on the 21st however, it may be the budget we transmit by March 7th to the county office for their review. We will be advertising the budget some time after March 7th but can make any adjustments necessary either to the income side or the expense side at the March 21st meeting so the ranges of the tax rate will be between 2.9 cents and 4.9 cents. One of the problems and concerns that we deal with is health benefits over the last 5 years have grown by \$7 million. We are receiving contributions by staff members but the full contribution rate will not be realized for another 4 years. Our staff has been reduced from 963 to 957 in this particular budget without any major impact to programs and we are hoping that by the end of the school year to have that number down to about 940. Although we have increases in health benefits by \$2.3 million, the actual expense side of the budget is only growing by \$675,000. We have tried to keep the integrity of the programs in this budget as well as not causing a large amount of RIF's therefore adding to the unemployment rate in Long Branch.

G. GENERAL ITEMS (continued)

Mr. Menkin commented on the exchange program with respect to the federal health care program.

Mr. Salvatore – We are researching all options and so far it appears that as long as we provide health benefits to 95% of our employees which we are doing, we will not be penalized under federal guidelines. We are continuing to review our budget and to reduce staff creatively and by 2016 our solar payment will be down to \$1 million and by 2017 it will be completely off of the books.

Mrs. Beams – Is the bank cap only good for one year?

Mr. Salvatore – We are only using a portion of bank cap to support this year's budget with regards to the increase of the tax levy. If there is additional breakage in the budget after March 21st, those funds will be used for tax relief in fiscal year 2015.

Mrs. Perez – Are we going to get the message out to the staff with respect to retirements, recognizing that the message did go out to the staff regarding tutors going back into the classroom.

Mr. Salvatore – We have gotten that message out. We are working with a pension consultant to help disseminate the information. The goal of this budget was not to RIF individuals and not to dramatically increase class sizes.

Mrs. Perez – If instructional assistants retire, are we going to replace them?

Mr. Salvatore – We have several one to one instructional assistants now that are IEP driven and they may be used if we were to get retirements in that area.

Mrs. Beams questioned the 4 day program in the summer and asked if that would pertain to all employees.

Mr. Salvatore – It would not be for 12 month employees. The main reason for doing this would be to help reduce utilities and the cost of the programs during the summer. The problem with 12 month employees is that for every day they have a sick day it would be counted as 1.25 days.

Mr. Grant inquired about next years stipend budget.

Mr. Salvatore – It is approximately \$900,000.

Mrs. Perez questioned the need for building facilitators if the building principals are present.

Mr. Salvatore – We will be evaluating this. We are still running a 6 week program especially for the special education children. By going to a 4 day week the Board will be saving \$250,000.

Mr. Parnell – Did Mr. Genovese have any discussions with Ron Mehlhorn?

Mr. Salvatore – Yes.

Mr. Salvatore – All of the transportation routes will be renewed at zero this year except for the Lenna Conrow School route which was tiered with the Anastasia School route. We will be going out to bid for that one.
