RESOLUTION

BOARD OF EDUCATION OF THE CITY OF LONG BRANCH, IN THE COUNTY OF MONMOUTH

July 22, 2015 Regular Meeting

RECITALS

- A. The Board of Education of the City of Long Branch, in the County of Monmouth ("Board of Education") as Seller entered into a Purchase and Sale Agreement with New Jersey Repertory Company ("Repertory Company") as Purchaser as of March 31, 2015 ("Agreement");
- B. The Agreement provides, *inter alia*, that the Repertory Company will purchase from the Board of Education property known as the "West End School", 132 West End Avenue in the City of Long Branch, County of Monmouth and State of New Jersey, also known as Block 123, Lot 13 on the Official Tax Map of the City of Long Branch, Monmouth County ("School");
- C. The Agreement also provides that Repertory Company has a period from March 31, 2015 through July 31, 2015 to conduct its due diligence of the School and Repertory Company has had an opportunity to and has completed its due diligence;
- D. Repertory Company has acknowledged that it will accept the condition of the School subject to the terms and conditions contained in the First Amendment to the Agreement ("First Amendment") as set forth in Paragraph 2 of this Resolution;

- E. The Agreement also provides the Repertory Company will make an additional deposit pursuant to the Agreement in the amount of \$100,000.00 on or before July 31, 2015 which Repertory Company is prepared to make subject to the signing of the First Amendment by both parties;
- F. The purchase price of the School as set forth in the Agreement is \$2,250,000.00;
- G. In consideration of certain findings by Repertory Company with respect to the condition of the School, the Board of Education has agreed to reduce the purchase price of the School from \$2,250,000.00 to \$2,152,500.00, a reduction of \$97,500.00;
- H. The Closing Date for the purchase and sale of the School, as more fully set forth in the Agreement, is November 13, 2015;
- I. The City of Long Branch adopted Ordinance No. 5-15 on or about April 28, 2015 by which it created an "overlay district" which includes the School, the result of which is that various of the uses for which Repertory School wishes to utilize the School are now permitted uses within the overlay district;
- J. On June 17, 2015, Scott Montgomery Kelly filed a complaint in the Superior Court of New Jersey, Monmouth County, Law Division, against the City of Long Branch and the Mayor and Council of the City of Long Branch, challenging the action of the City in creating the overlay district;
- K. Both the Board of Education and Repertory Company are uncertain as to what effect, if any, the suit will have on the School as a result of which Repertory Company

has requested additional time to seek approval of an Application for Development to be filed by Repertory Company as set forth in Recital L and to evaluate the potential litigation risk regarding the overlay zone;

- L. Repertory Company agrees to file an Application for Development with either the Planning Board or Zoning Board of Adjustment of the City of Long Branch on or before October 1, 2015 and use its best efforts to have the Application for Development approved by the Planning Board or Zoning Board of Adjustment as soon as practicable;
- M. The Board of Education is willing to extend the Closing Date to March 1, 2016 provided Repertory Company files its Application for Development on or before October 1, 2015;
- N. As Repertory Company will accept the condition of the School and there is no mortgage contingency set forth in the Agreement, upon the signing of the First Amendment, the only reason for which Repertory Company may terminate the Agreement and declare same to be of no force and effect if it has failed to obtain approval of its Application for Development by March 1, 2016, and/or if in its sole opinion, the litigation risk regarding the overlay zone or any potential appeals regarding any approvals obtained are of such a concern that future development and construction of the property would be compromised by virtue of any appeals or litigation risks. Repertory Company may have until March 1, 2016 to make such a decision and if it elects to terminate the Agreement, it shall be entitled to receive the return of all deposits made on account of the Agreement; and

O. In the event on or before March 1, 2016 Repertory Company fails to notify the Board of Education that it does not wish to proceed with the Closing based on the

failure of its Application for Development to be finally approved, the Closing shall take place

on March 10, 2016, in accordance with the terms and conditions of the Agreement and the

First Amendment.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED as follows:

1. The Recitals set forth above are incorporated into and made a part of

this Resolution.

2. Legal counsel for the Board of Education shall prepare a First

Amendment in form satisfactory to the Repertory Company, the President, Superintendent of

Schools and School Business Administrator of the Board of Education respectively and

present same for signature to the Repertory Company and the President and Secretary of the

Board of Education which, when signed, shall amend the Agreement, as more fully set forth

therein.
