A-1. STATEMENT OF THE MANNER OF NOTIFICATION OF THE MEETING

In rare instances, matters are presented to the Board of Education for discussion at the same meeting that final action may be taken.





1. Instruction & Program in the Distance Learning Environment - Presented by Dr. Roberta Freeman, Chief Academic Officer. Dr. Freeman reviewed, "A Virtual Day in the Life..." in which the following items were thoroughly addressed:
 - a. Distance Learning Schedules - Each grade span (Prek-K, 1-5, 6-8 and 9-12) were reviewed. Highlights of the schedules demonstrated both live lessons and independent learning. Additionally, student support, office hours and professional learning were also discussed. Schedules were created based on best practices, distance learning research, as well as, data collected from the unique needs of our learning community.
 - b. It All Starts With... - The ClassLink Launchpad for the district was viewed. ClassLink provides students, parents and teachers with one dashboard containing all the resources needed for a grade level. By using ClassLink, parents and students do not have to remember several passwords for the many applications used. ClassLink stores this information, therefore, to navigate their day, students should begin everyday with ClassLink.
 - i. ClassLink Resource Video
 - ii. District Launchpad
 - c. Standards-Based Instruction - This was broken down into three areas:
 - i. Standards-Based Support - The district has developed a guidance document to assist teachers in providing students with standards-based instruction. *Considerations for Addressing Unfinished Learning* provides teachers with research-based methods for instruction. Students have missed six months of school and it is important that we as a school community continue learning by providing ***Just In Time Learning*** as opposed to *Just In Case Teaching*.
 - ii. Researched based Programs - To support instruction, the district has implemented two researched based programs that will support student growth in grade level standards.
 1. Waterford Early Learning System (Prek-K)
 2. iReady (Grades 1-8)

- iii. Student Experience - Three words sum up the student experience: Diagnostic, Adaptive, Personalized. Programs being utilized will identify gaps in learning with diagnostic assessments, the software is designed to adapt the student's learning (enrich and challenge students while also providing just in time learning for areas needing more attention). Diagnostic assessment paired with adaptive opens the door for teachers to provide students with a personalized learning path.
 - d. Research - By utilizing distance learning resources such as the Distance Learning Playbook by Doug Fisher and Nancy Frey, the district is confident that we have established a solid foundation for our virtual learning environment.
- 2. Report on Graduation



Safety iPass was developed with concerns from over 200 school leaders throughout the United States and combined with information and protocols from the Center for Disease Control (CDC), those recommendations along with our personal needs here in Long Branch resulted in the Safety iPass Self-Certification tool.

With Safety iPass, the LBPS can more efficiently and effectively admit staff, students, and visitors into our buildings. All staff are required to answer a self-certification questionnaire (takes 10-15 seconds) and based upon their answers will receive a digital colored badge that will either grant or deny them access to any LBPS facility.

Staff have two options in receiving or accessing the iPass self-certification. All LBPS staff receive an email to their district issued account between 6:00 a.m. and 6:30 a.m. with a link to the questionnaire. The second way to complete the form is directly through the application on their personal cellular device.

When students return to our facilities, parents will also get an email asking them to complete a form for each of their children attending the LBPS. Working with CrisisGo, these emails and questionnaires published in three languages, English, Spanish and Portuguese.

The state has also required that district keep track of cleaning of bathroom rooms and high touch areas during the pandemic. The LBPS are the first to have a digital checklist for all sites, every bathroom, and high touch areas where our custodians can complete a time and date stamped report.

Another state requirement is for districts to create a reporting system for employees who arrived at work healthy, but during the day start to feel ill. The LBPS and CrisisGo are currently developing a reporting application.

New for 2020-2021, districts had to comply with Allyssa's Law, where a silent alarm needed to be installed at the secretary's desk at the front door with a direct access to law enforcement. The LBPS have taken the proactive approach and put the silent alarm on every CrisisGo device within the district. It has a direct line to the Monmouth County 9-1-1 center and the Long Branch Police Department.

Motorola radio system that the district uses has reached end of life. It is over 20-years old and we are unable to purchase replacement parts. We are exploring AT&T FirstNet, established after 9/11 for first responders. Sonim XP8 are the devices that the LBPS will use to replace our outdated radios. All devices and supporting equipment are available on state contract.

1. As per Shore Conference Constitution, all fees are approved recommendations from the Executive Committee. Individual Schools or Boards of Education are not mandated to pay these recommended fees.
2. If an official reports for a game and the game is postponed before it starts, due to weather/field conditions, the official should receive a full game rate for that level they were assigned.
3. If a school is notified that only one official is supplied, that official should be paid the following:
* Sub Varsity receives a varsity fee; * Varsity receives a varsity rate plus ½ Varsity rate.
4. If a school requests a Sub Varsity official in Wrestling and only has a few wrestlers, the official receives a full Sub Varsity fee. If a Varsity official is asked to do a few Sub Varsity matches should be paid \$5.00 per match up to five matches. Anything over five matches is a Sub Varsity fee.
5. Individual Gymnasts competing in meets with other Shore Conference teams shall pay the following official fee: \$7.00 per judge per event.
6. If a school requests an official to travel out of the Shore area for a NJSIAA state game/match there shall be a travel fee equal to that sport's Sub Varsity fee. If the NJSIAA assigns an official from the Shore, no travel fee is required.
