## The Sacrifice Bunt

1. Move up in the box when executing the bunt. (This gives you a little more fair territory to work with.
2. Starting in a normal batting stance, the hitter rotates their back foot so that their body is squarely facing the pitcher.
3. At the same time, the top hand should start sliding up the barrel of the bat and moving it into proper position.
4. The top hand should end up about halfway up the barrel, with the bat positioned comfortably between the thumb and index finger.
5. The batter should be in a balanced and comfortable position, with the knees bent.
6. He should also be leaning forward with most of his weight on the front leg.
