



## Transition of Care Request- Long Branch

If you or your dependent is currently under a treatment plan with a provider who was participating in-network prior to 1/1/16, but will not be in the new provider network after 1/1/16, you may be eligible for a “transition of care” level of benefits for continuity of care.

**Examples** of medical conditions appropriate for the transition level of benefits include, but are not limited to:

- Women in their second or third trimester of pregnancy and up to 8 weeks postpartum;
- Women who have been diagnosed as potentially having a moderate or high risk pregnancy;
- Patients undergoing treatment for cancer;
- Organ transplant candidates awaiting a donor or under active treatment;
- Inpatient at the time of the network change;
- Previous treatment for behavioral health;
- Within three months post-acute injury or surgery

If you are currently in active treatment by a provider who will not be a member of the PPO network in your area, and you would like Integrity Health to determine if your medical condition qualifies for transition level benefits, please complete the form below.
